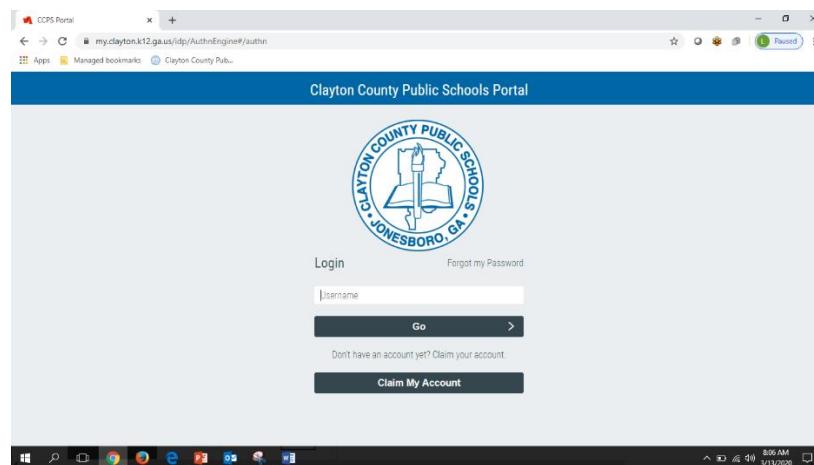
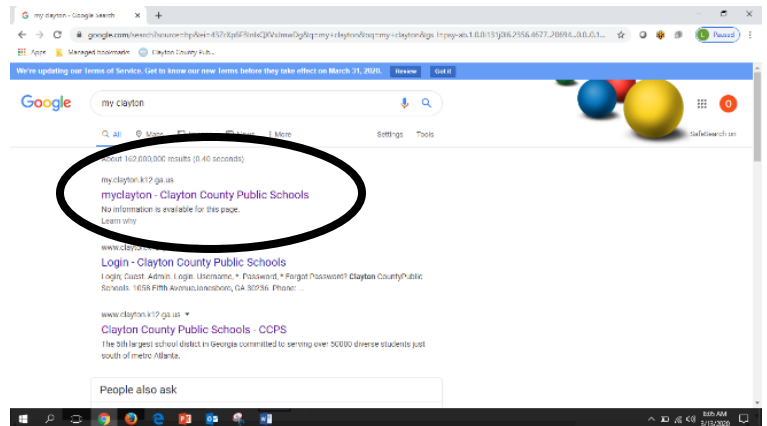
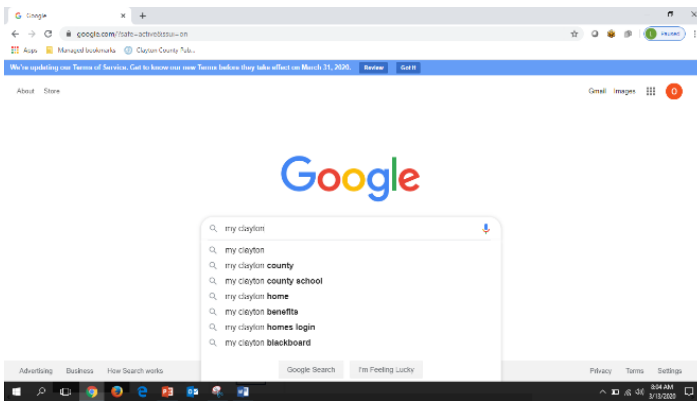


How to access online Church Street Lessons:

Visit www.google.com and type in "my clayton". It is the first result. Click on the first link.

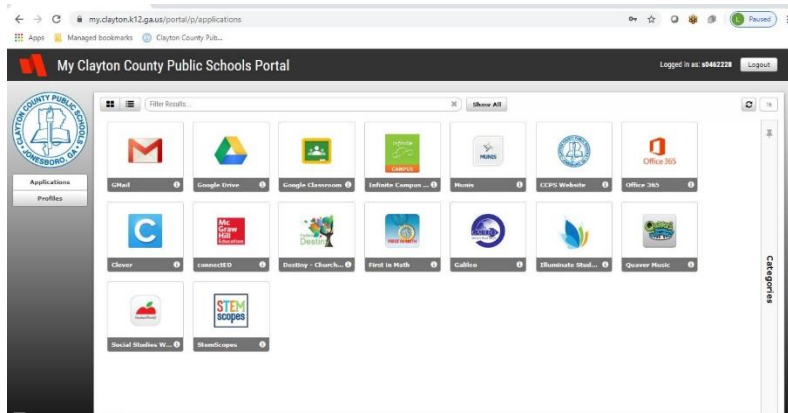


Step Two:

Step Three:

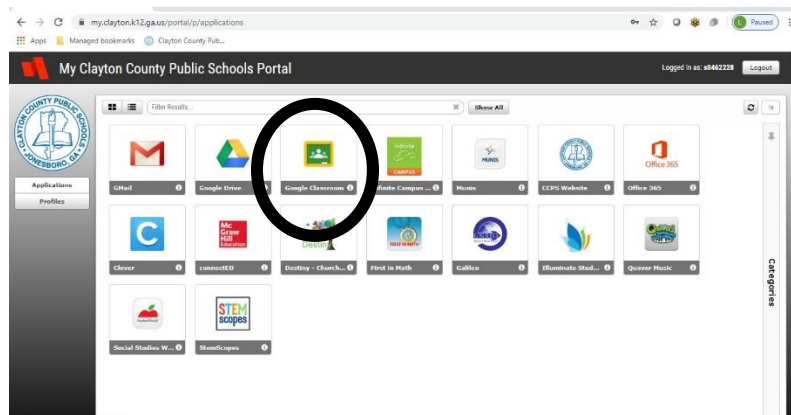
Put in your student's password. For the most part, the password should be ccps1234. (No period, all lowercase letters). If entered correctly, this is what the "landing page" looks like.



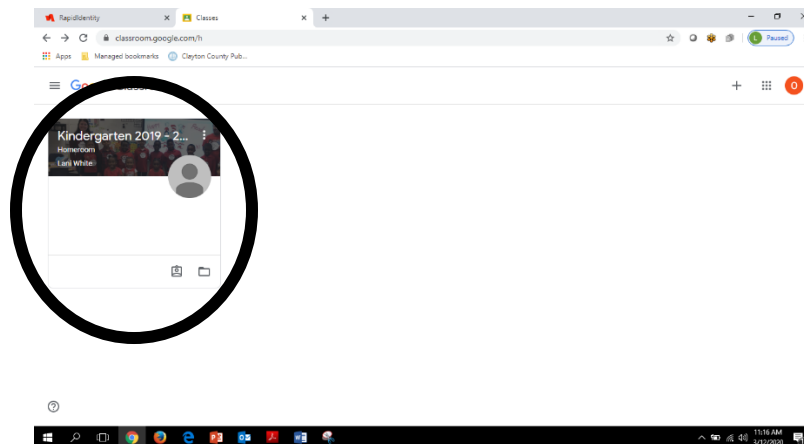
To Access Online Classes:

Click on the Google Classroom. It looks like a chalkboard.

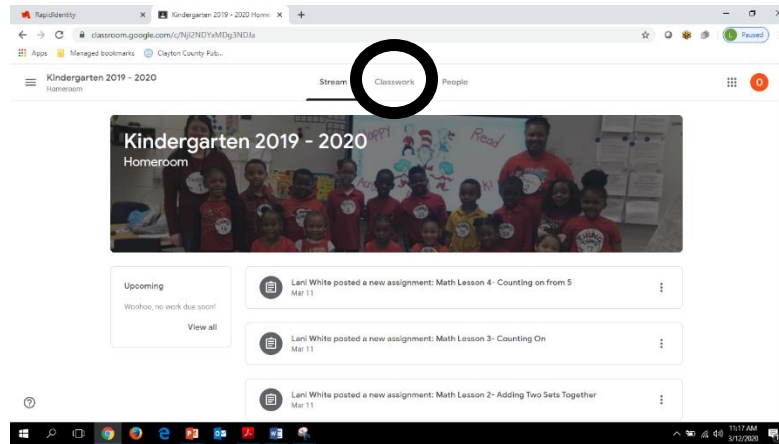


Step Two: Click on your student's class



Step Three:

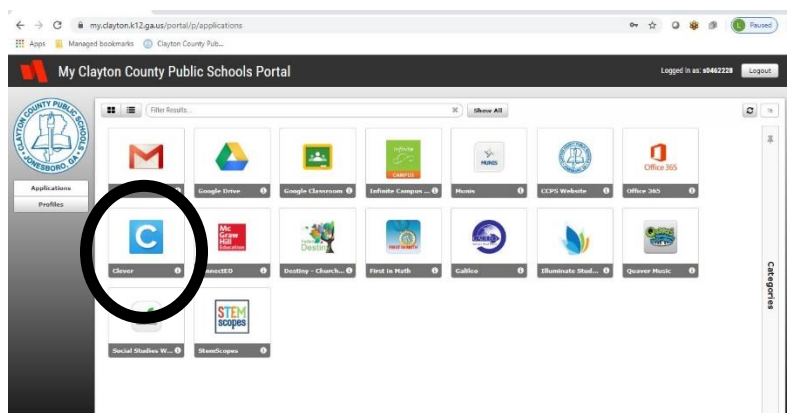
Click on "Classwork"

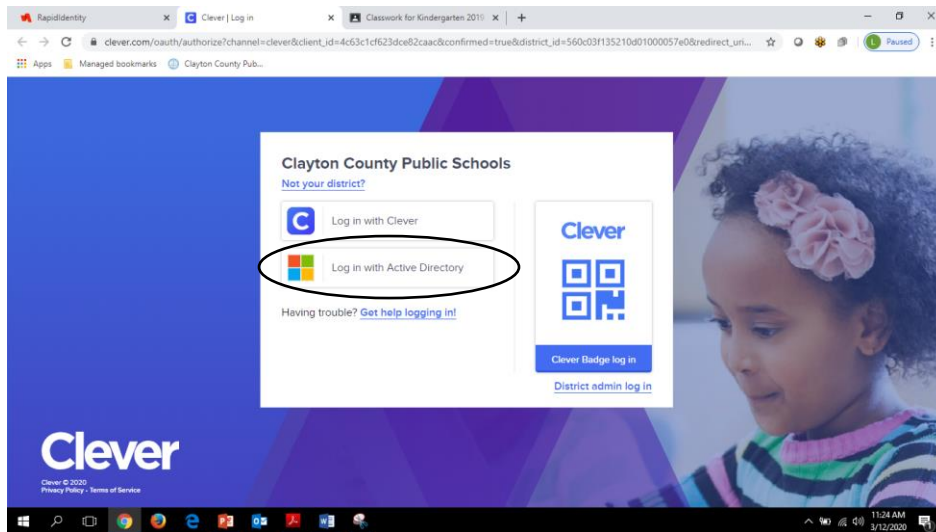
To access iReady Lessons (online reading and math curriculum):

Step One: Follow the directions above to login. Instead of clicking on Google Classroom, click on "clever".



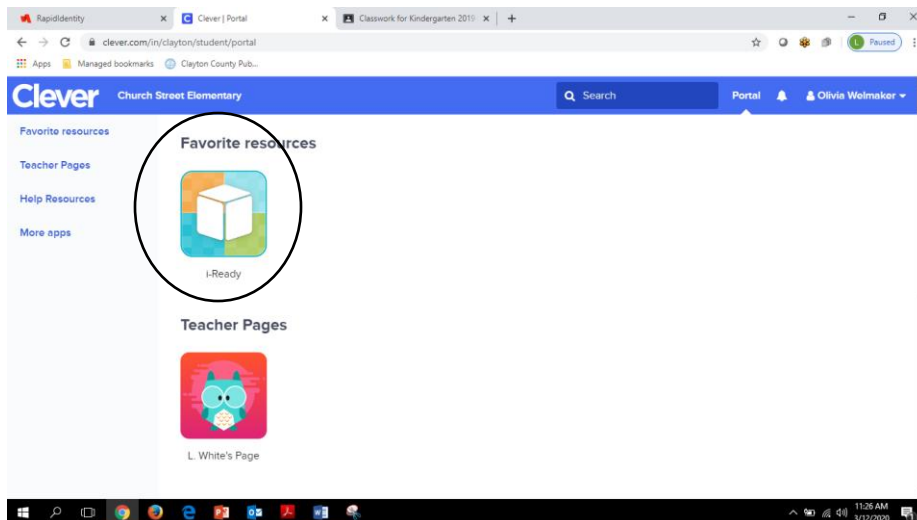
Step Two:
